

## JURISDICTION-SPECIFIC SUPPLEMENT TO DIGITAL SCIENCE PRIVACY NOTICES

This Additional Privacy Notice is intended to provide additional information about the privacy, collection and use of personal data or similar as may be required in certain jurisdictions.

### California

If you are a California “consumer”, you may be entitled to receive additional information and/or additional rights under applicable laws, including the California Consumer Privacy Act or “CCPA”, and the California Privacy Rights Act or “CPRA” (“**Californian Privacy Laws**”). If you are not a California consumer, please ignore this section, which does not apply to you.

References in the Privacy Notice to “personal data” shall be deemed to relate to “personal information” as defined under the Californian Privacy Laws, as applicable.

**Categories of personal information collected.** Depending on how you engage with Digital Science and its solutions, which may be as a service provider, product user or otherwise, the personal information that we may collect, or may have collected from California consumers in the preceding twelve months, fall into the following categories established by the CCPA: Identifiers, such as your name, alias, address, phone number, or IP address; “Personal Information” as described in Section 1798.80(e) of the California Civil Code; Characteristics of protected classifications under California or federal law, such as race or gender, for example if we conduct user surveys; Commercial information; Internet or other electronic network activity information; Geolocation data, such as the location of your device; Audio, visual, electronic, or other similar information; Professional or employment-related information; and Non-publicly available educational information as defined under FERPA. In some cases, we may also occasionally collect sensitive personal information as defined by the CPRA, such as social security numbers, for example of our contractors, or information that reveals racial or ethnic origin, for example if we conduct user surveys.

For more details about the personal information we may collect, including where it is collected and the different “business purposes” or “commercial purposes” it was used for, please see the “How do we collect and use personal data?” section of the Privacy Notice.

**Sharing your personal information:** In the preceding 12 months, we have not “sold” or “shared”, as defined by the Californian Privacy Laws, your personal information. We may otherwise share your information confidentially with others as described in the “Who we share your personal data with” section of the Privacy Notice.

**Data Retention:** We keep your personal data for as long as it is necessary for the purposes for which it was collected, after which it will be destroyed. Please see the “Security and storage” section of the Privacy Notice for further information.

**Cookies:** We use cookies and similar technologies (including third-party cookies) - please see our cookie policy, which also allows you to manage your cookie settings (including opting out of certain cookies and similar technologies).

**Your rights:** Subject to certain limitations, the CCPA provides you the right to request to know more details about the categories or specific pieces of personal information we collect (including how we use and disclose this information), to delete your personal information, to opt out of any "sales" that may be occurring and to not be discriminated against for exercising these rights.
